It was put in before EIR (Coyote side to Los Alamitos side). Will it take an EIR to remove it? They are also going to find out how much is spent annually in maintenance on the canal presently.

Matt also brought up that permits have been taken out to build on lots of courts on foothill drive. Forrest recommends planning department as best source of information.
